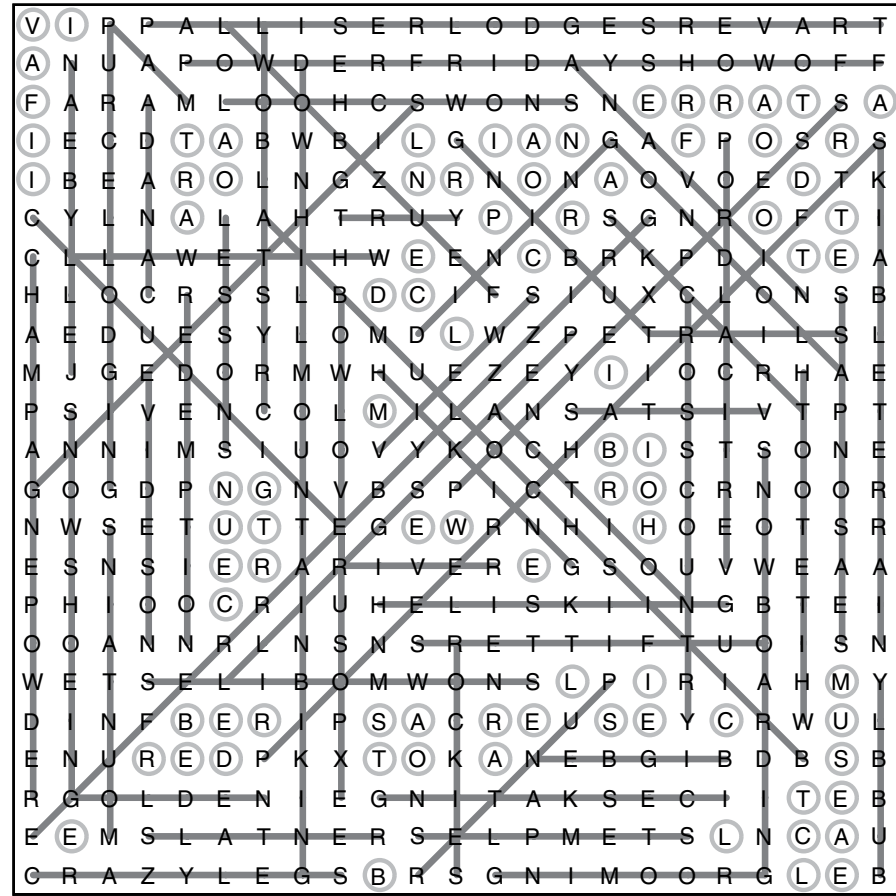


MONSTER FIND-A-WORD KICKING HORSE RESORT

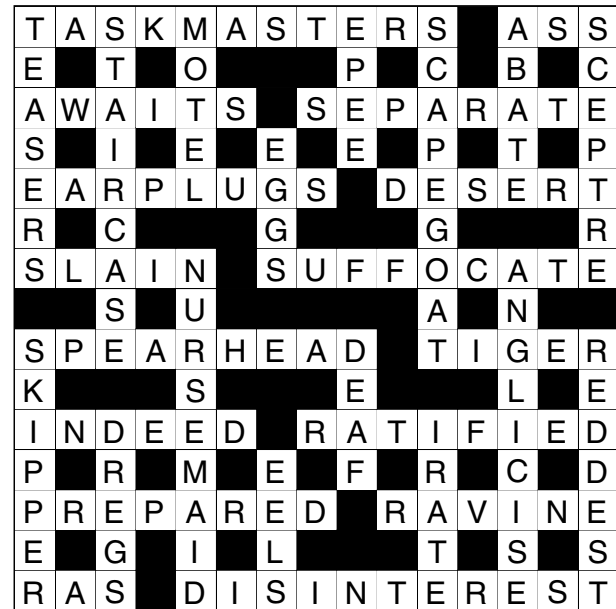

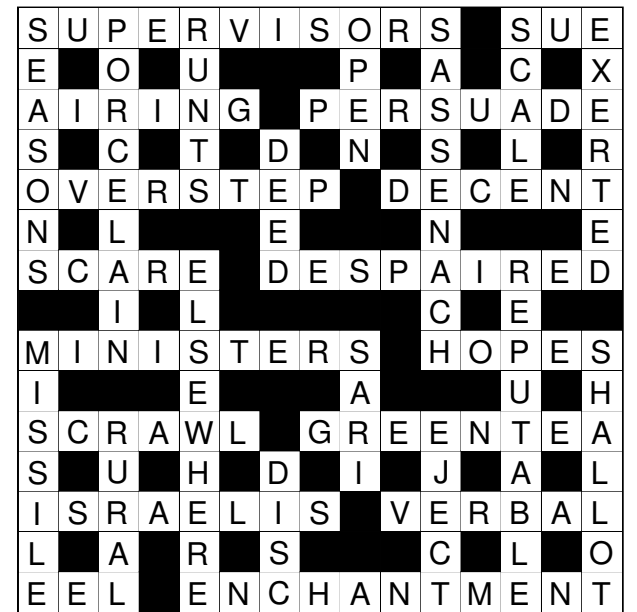

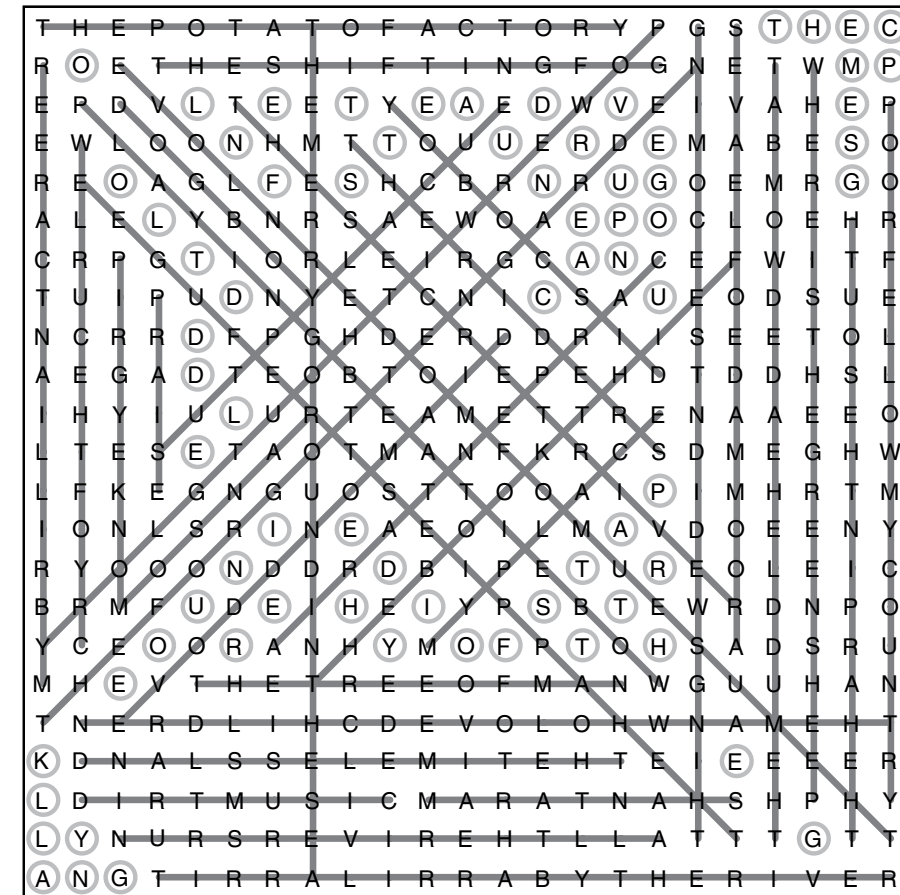
