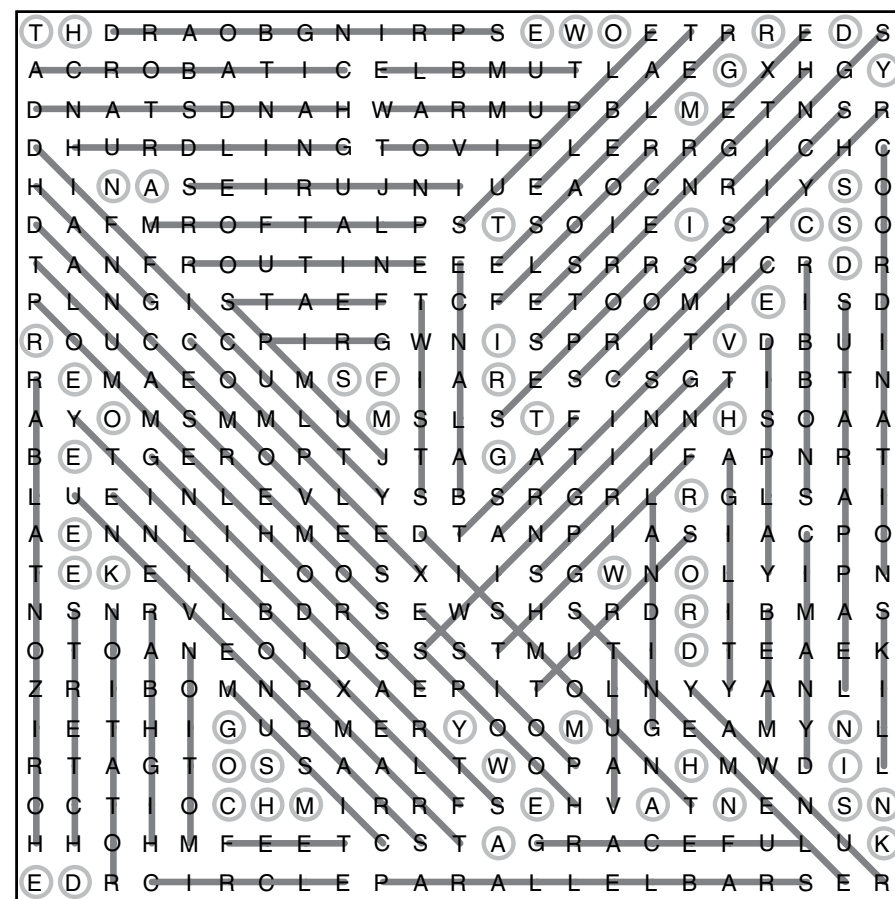


### MONSTER FIND-A-WORD IN THE GYMNASIUM

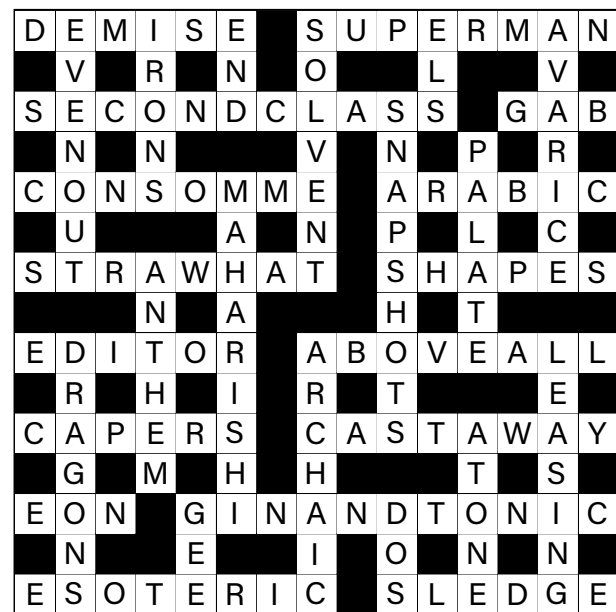

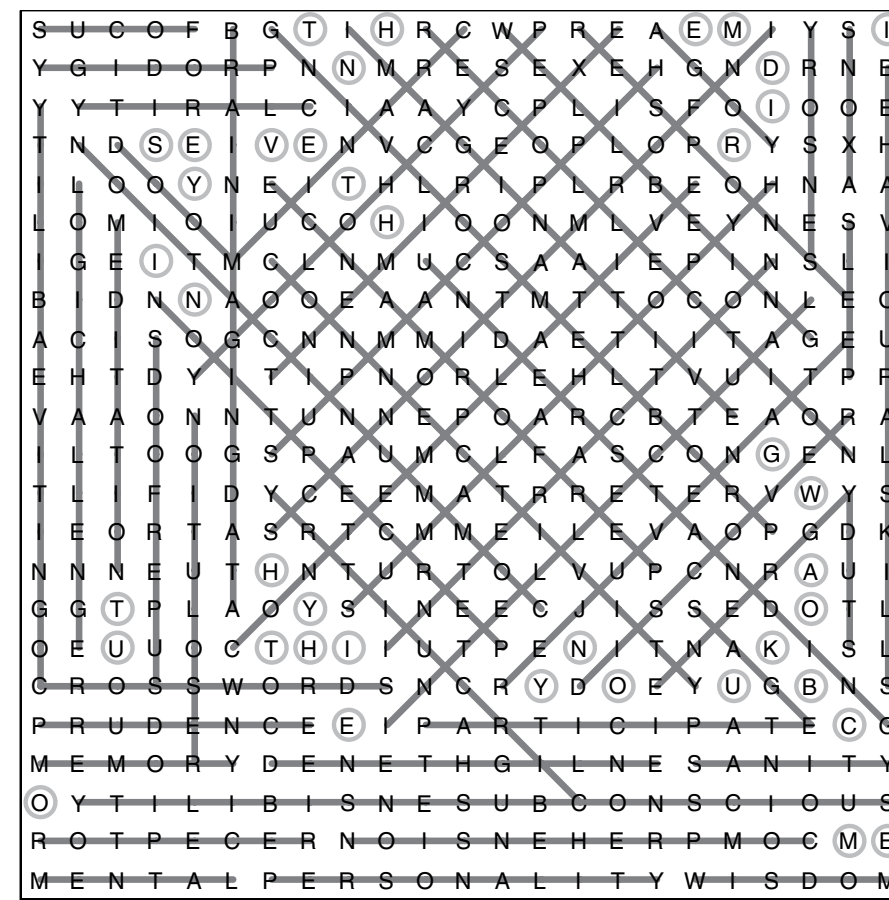
