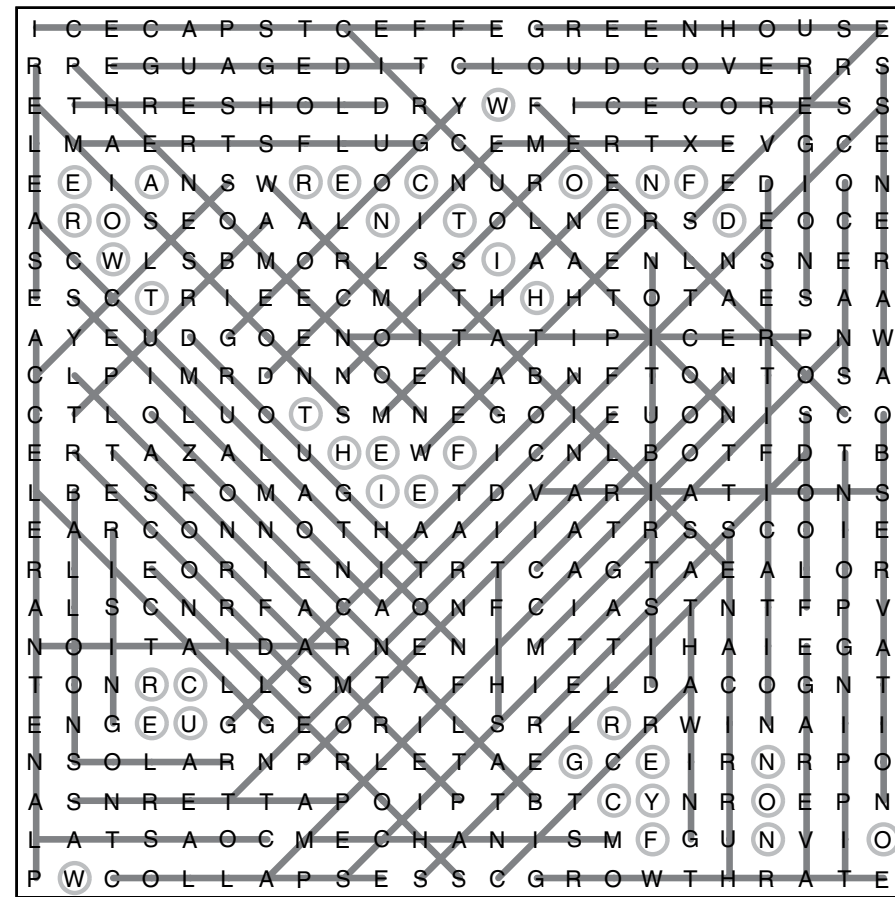


MONSTER FIND-A-WORD CLIMATE CHANGE

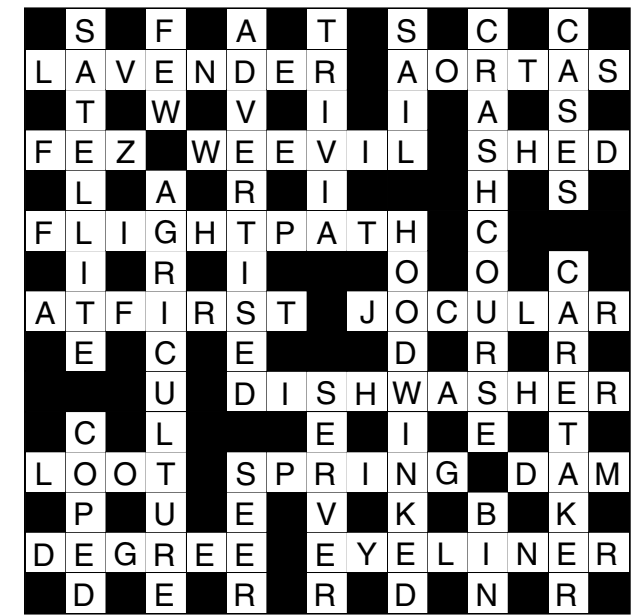

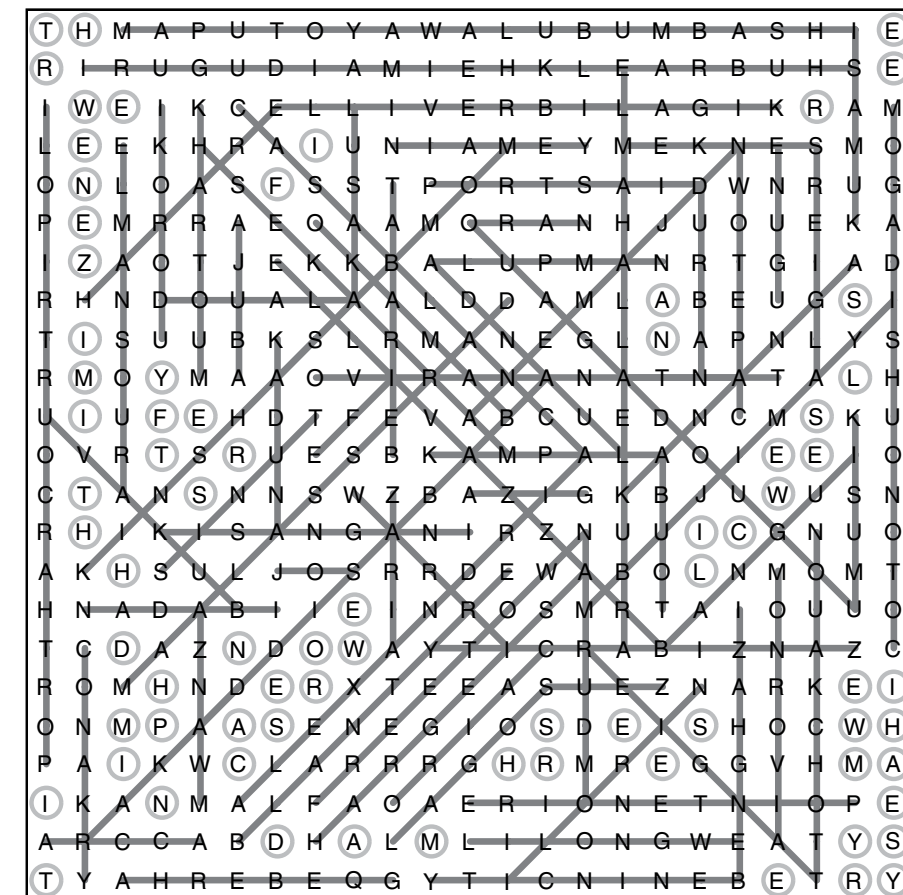
